The Mercedes-Benz 380SE is new to the legendary "S-Class" range of saloons. With it comes exhilarating performance in the form of the alloy V8 3.8 litre engine that until now has been reserved for the larger, longer wheelbase "S-Class" Mercedes saloons in Australia. This quite remarkable power plant produces an incomparable 145 kw and 295 Nm of torque. It is very much an engine of today. You can feel its urgency and responsiveness through the accelerator. Its engine block is not the usual cast iron, but silicon impregnated light alloy for a superb power to weight ratio. It features a single overhead camshaft for each bank of four cylinders and state-of-the-art Bosch continuous fuel injection teamed with contact-less transistorised ignition. Of course, the 380SE engine has a plug-in provision for engine testing and computerized tuning adjustment. It will not surprise you to learn that most Formula One racing drivers choose a Mercedes-Benz "S-Class" as their personal road car. The reasons stretch far beyond straight-line performance.

The 380SE offers unequalled driving satisfaction because of its integrity of design.

Its outstanding handling and cornering ability are enhanced by the revolutionary anti-skid ABS braking system.

No detail has been overlooked. The 380SE has automatic cruise control with precise fingertip over-ride. The independent rear suspension
system is self-levelling. The headlamps can be
adjusted for vehicle load by using an indexing
wheel on the dashboard.
