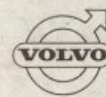

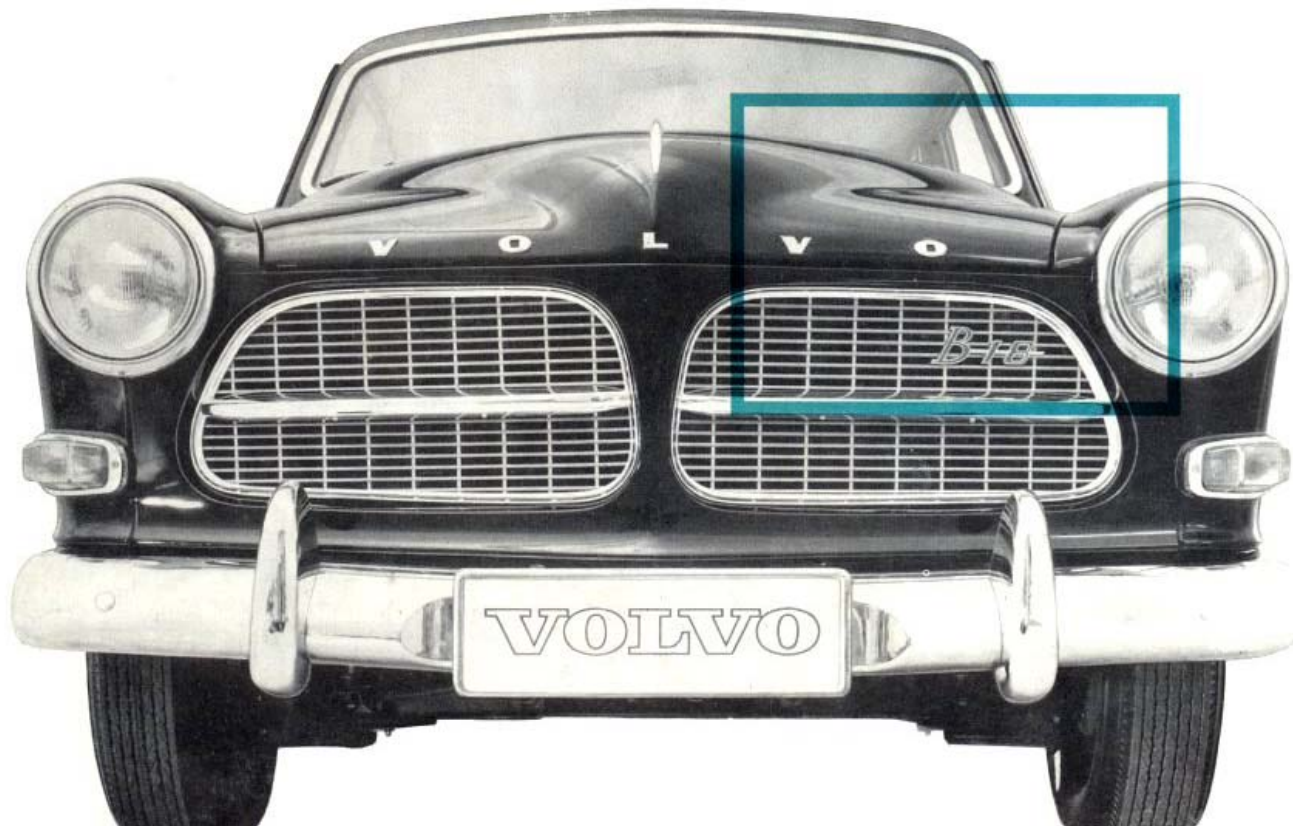

The B18 Engine—for power, reliability, economy



The Volvo 120 series consists of high quality modern cars with pleasing style and exceptional performance.

The cars in this series are roomy and comfortable and have excellent driving and road-holding properties. For this reason they appeal to those who want a safe long-distance vehicle which is at the same time representative—easy to handle in congested traffic situations and easy to park in small spaces.

All Volvo cars are designed with a view to maximum safety. They have all-welded integral steel bodies which are extremely resistant to stresses. Cars with the lively 75 h.p. B 18 A engine (Volvo 121) have effective drum brakes all round. Cars which are fitted with the still more powerful 90 h.p. B 18 D engine (Volvo 122 S) have disc brakes at the front and drum brakes at the rear. A Volvo has good acceleration for safe overtaking. It also has very short braking distances.

Volvo cars are built to withstand hard climates. They are all-year-round cars with effective rust-protection and perfect weather-proofing. The 12-volt electrical system facilitates starting from cold and has sufficient resources for radio, extra lighting equipment and other electrical accessories.

Volvo cars are well-known throughout the world for their high quality. This results from the exacting demands placed by Volvo in the fundamental design, choice of materials, manufacturing and inspection processes.

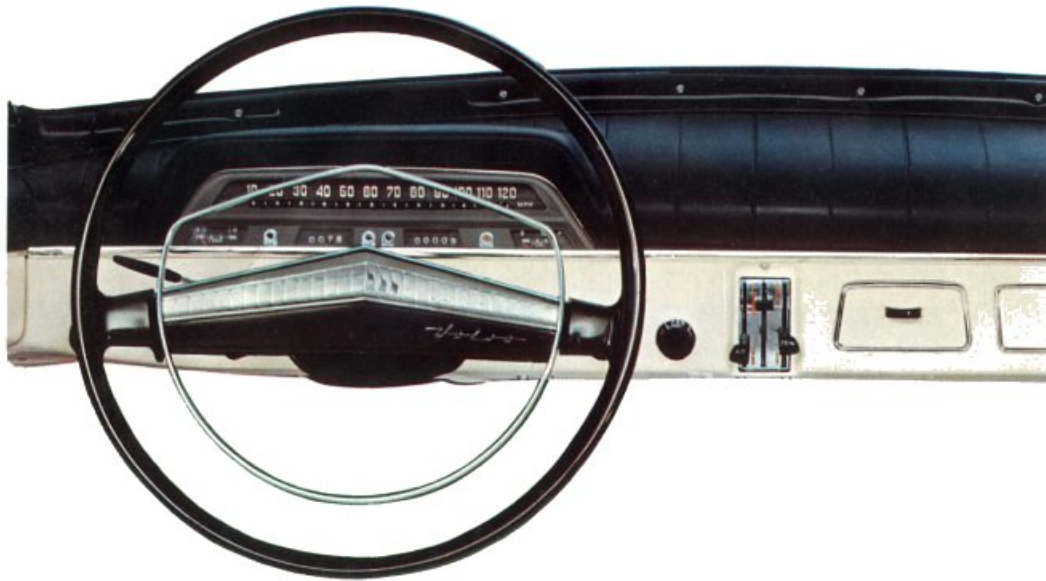

THE VOLVO 120 SERIES





Clear, easily-read instruments are placed immediately in front of the driver. The steering wheel is of the safety type and is positioned at the most suitable angle for comfortable and safe steering. The top of the instrument panel is padded and covered with reflection-free fabric. The underside is smooth and free from obstructions.

The individual front seats are suitably shaped and are padded to the right consistency. The rear seat is built up in the same manner as the front seats and offers comfortable passenger accommodation. The upholstery consists of hard-wearing leatherette which harmonizes well with the paintwork. The floor is covered with rubber mats. These are practical and easy to keep clean.



VOLVO 121/122 S FOUR-DOOR



The four-door Volvo has class. It is fast, safe and easy to drive, and has ample standard equipment for pleasant journeys. The four doors give access to a luxurious and well-planned interior. A heater and demister system fed by fresh air gives an agreeable temperature and free all-round vision even during cold weather. The fresh air supply is thermostatically controlled. This means that it is possible to select a certain degree of heating which remains constant regardless of driving conditions.

It is a real experience to drive a Volvo. The powerful and reliable B18 engine reacts instantly to the slightest pressure on the accelerator pedal. The steering is easy and precise, and the road-holding properties are remarkable. The gearbox, which has definite gear positions and well-balanced gear ratios, is controlled by a floor-mounted gear lever. Thanks to the excellent synchronizing properties of the gearbox, gear changing can be carried out very quickly.
